Annual Meeting and Summary of Bylaws

The following information is provided in accordance with the requirements of the Rural Utility Services (RUS):

The Cooperative's annual meeting shall be held each year on the date designated by the Board of Directors.

Notices shall be mailed to each member prior to each annual meeting.

Each member shall be entitled to one vote on each item submitted at the meeting.

All questions shall be decided by majority vote of those members present or represented by mail.

Each director shall select and appoint a member of the Nominating Committee.

The members of the Nominating Committee shall nominate cooperative members for vacancies on the Board of Directors in accordance with the prescribed director area representation.

A statement of the nominations shall be mailed to each member not later than sixty days prior to the annual meeting.

The Cooperative's complete bylaws are printed in the information pages of your telephone directory.

How to Watch Online

1. Get a Password

You will need your Citizens Mutual account number leading with the 000 (it's on your bill) and a valid email address to register for a free WatchTVEverywhere password. Once you register, you will receive a confirmation email and you will need to click on the link in that email to complete your registration.

2. Log in

- USING A WEB BROWSER – Go to WatchTVEverywhere.com and enter your email address and password. Then click on the logo of the service you want to watch, and select programming from the on-screen menu.
- USING A MOBILE DEVICE – After you log-in with your password at WatchTVEverywhere.com, click the network you want to watch. At each network's page you'll find links to free Android and iOS apps you can download to watch on mobile devices. The first time you use a new app on your device, you will be prompted to select Citizens Mutual from a list of providers and enter your [WatchTVEverywhere](http://WatchTVEverywhere.com) password. Just remember if you are logging onto your phone you may be using your cellular data!

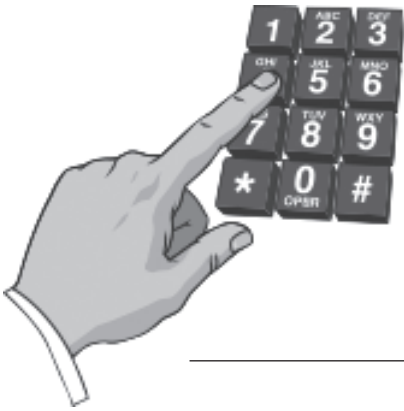

1. In this rural Broadband Association geographic area, a \$2,500 FRS (Foundation of Rural Service) Scholarship will be given as well as a \$2,500 NTCA Scholarship. These applications may be picked up from the high school guidance counselor or from Citizens Mutual. Applications must be postmarked no later than March 2, 2016.

The Iowa Communications Alliance is pleased to announce the availability of college scholarships in the amount of \$2,500 and \$1,500 to high school seniors or students currently enrolled in an institution of higher learning.
